# The Baptism of the Lord

**God declares Jesus as His beloved Son.**

Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan to be baptized by him.

John tried to prevent him, saying,

"I need to be baptized by you, and yet you are coming to me?"

Jesus said to him in reply,

"Allow it now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness."

Then he allowed him.

After Jesus was baptized,

he came up from the water and behold,

the heavens were opened for him,

and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon him.

And a voice came from the heavens, saying,

"This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

Matthew 3:13-17

This Gospel passage highlights the humility and obedience of Jesus. Despite being sinless, Jesus chose to be baptized by John to fulfill all righteousness. This act signifies Jesus' solidarity with humanity and his commitment to God's plan. The descent of the Spirit and the voice from heaven affirm Jesus' divine sonship and God's pleasure in him. This moment marks the beginning of Jesus' public ministry, emphasizing the importance of humility, obedience, and divine approval in our own lives.
