Message from our Pastor:

"September: A Month to Encounter God's Word"

This month we celebrate a remarkable figure: Saint Jerome, priest, hermit, and Doctor of the Church, who died on September 30, 420. Saint Jerome dedicated his life to Sacred Scripture, translating much of the Bible into Latin (the famous Vulgate) so that everyone could understand and approach God.

To mark the 1600th anniversary of his death, Pope Francis wrote an Apostolic Letter called *Scripturae Sacrae Affectus*, "Devotion to Sacred Scripture." In it, he reminds us that Saint Jerome had a "living and tender love" for the Bible, dedicating his life to serve the Gospel.

Pope Francis also points out that although there are many translations today, each enriches the Word of God, because Scripture "grows with the reader," speaking to the heart of each culture and generation.

This month's invitation:

- Let us be like St. Jerome: bring the Bible into our homes.
- Read, even just a small passage each day—like the Sunday Gospel—and talk about what it says to us.
- Ask, as he did, that the Word not stay on a shelf but accompany and transform us.

Closing prayer:

Lord, may the Word of your life light my path, as it did for Saint Jerome, and may our community open our hearts to hear your voice each day.
