Pastor's Message

A New Year, a New Step as a Parish

As we begin this new year, I would like to share with you the pastoral direction we will be taking together. This is not simply about activities or events, but about listening to God's will and responding with faithfulness and hope.

1. Renewal and Continuity of the Pastoral Council

One of our first steps will be the selection of new members for the Pastoral Council, with the desire to give continuity to the work that has already begun and to strengthen what we have built together.

Today, the names of the possible candidates who may join this already active council will be presented. I ask you to accompany this process with prayer, so that the Holy Spirit may grant us servants with generous hearts and a deep love for the Church.

2. A Parish That Prays for Vocations

This year we will also join the diocesan pastoral initiative to promote vocations to the priesthood and the consecrated life. We want to be a parish that prays, accompanies, and discerns, trusting that God continues to call today.
