Stewardship of God's Gifts (Stewardship) - 4

Stewardship of Treasure - Giving with Trust in God

We have reflected lately on what it means to be **stewards of God's gifts (Stewardship)**, offering our time and our talents in service to the Lord and His Church.

Today we reflect on another important aspect of Christian life: **our treasure**, the material goods that God has entrusted to us.

Everything we have is a gift from God. Our work, our income, and our possessions are also part of the blessings we receive through His providence.

The Gospel reminds us:

"Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also" (Matthew 6:21).

When we offer to God a portion of what we have received, we express our trust in Him and recognize that everything comes from His love.

Giving is not simply helping with material needs; it is a spiritual act. It helps us live with gratitude, grow in generosity, and remember that God always provides for His children.

Our parish exists thanks to the generosity of many people who, with sacrifice and love, offer part of what they have to support the mission of the Church.
