WHY BECOME A REFEREE

- Learn the rules of the game
- Become a better player
- Lifelong lessons of responsibility and accountability
- Learn to handle adverse situations

How it Works

- All matches must have “certified” referees. YOU CANNOT REFEREE IF YOU ARE NOT CERTIFIED.
- Certification progress occurs annually.
- Once your certification is complete, we will work to get you assigned games.



NEW REFEREE PROCESS

STEPS:

1. Create an account
2. Register for the online course
3. Pay the fees (\$60)
4. Complete online courses (~4 hours)
5. Attend in-person clinic (~2-3 hours)

*Background check and for referees over 18 years of age
(\$30 – good for two years)*

HOW MUCH CAN I MAKE?

- League games: anywhere from \$30-\$80 per game
- Tournament games: anywhere from \$25-\$70 per game (\$500+ in one weekend)
- Progression: stay with it and eventually referee college matches ... \$150-\$600 per game!



HOW QUICKLY AM I PAID?

New for 2024!

NOTCH

Referees paid as quickly as the same day.

Work game → submit game report (verify attendances) → paid upon approval.

No longer waiting several weeks to be paid!



ASSIGNING PHILOSOPHY

- We assign you matches based on experience and comfort level
 - Age
 - Referee experience
 - Comfort
- Several ways to be assigned (<http://live.joinnotch.com>), which will be covered in a document you will receive after completing your certification



PARENT ROLE

- We believe that refereeing soccer is a good entry into developing good life skills.
- With that said, we ask that you ensure that your referee is at EVERY match in which they are assigned and accepted.
- No different than your son or daughter coming home from a game or practice.... "how did it go" can be a lead in to good discussion and support.
