Listed below are some of the scam tactics to avoid.

Door to Door Sales -

If a person shows up at your door and claims they are a paving company, BE CAUTIOUS! They may claim they have leftover asphalt from a job and offer to pave your driveway at a discounted price. Within a few months the asphalt may begin to crack and need repairs. They may provide you with an invalid phone number and be completely unable to reach.

No Contract-

If a company intends to start your project without a written contract, this is another sign that you are the target of a scam. Contracts are in place to protect both the business and the customer. Without a contract the terms of the deal are subject to change.

3 Year Warranty-

If you are being offered a 3-year warranty, BEWARE! Most all legitimate paving companies offer a standard 1-year warranty.

"Special Asphalt"-

If an unscrupulous provider claims they get "Special Asphalt" this is a scam. ALL paving companies get their asphalt from the same plants.

❖ Too Good to Be True-

If a company baits you into disclosing their other bids; then claims they can beat any other price, this is another sign you may be getting scammed. Remember: If it sounds too good to be true it usually is.

Do a Google search of the company and its owner as this will provide you with information about their reputation and the person you are doing business with.
