2026 Scholarships to support Youth in Agriculture

Scholarships on offer:

As of 1 January 2024, Castle Hill & Hills District Agricultural Society have introduced Agricultural Scholarships to support Youth who are passionate about agricultural pursuits and committed to furthering their knowledge in the rural industry. There will be 3 scholarships on offer for the 2026 Tuition year.

Details of Scholarships:

Scholarships will be offered on an application basis to those members who in 2026 are undertaking secondary or tertiary studies in the field of Agriculture. Those studying a Tertiary approved Agriculture or related agricultural course or Secondary students entering year 11 or 12 and have selected agriculture subjects towards their Higher School Certificate will be eligible to apply.

Scholarships will be valued between \$1,500 - \$3,000. The funds will be paid directly to the successful applicants' educational institution.

Eligibility requirements:

- Scholarships will be offered to members of the Castle Hill & Hills District Agricultural Society who have held a full society membership for at least one year before applying for the Scholarship. (Junior members under 18, must also have a family member hold an adult membership for the qualifying period). Membership must be financial for the entire period in which the member is in receipt of the scholarship.
- Application for a scholarship can be made from the second or any subsequent year of holding continuous membership of the Society.
- Scholarships will be awarded for a 12 month period only, however a member who has received a scholarship may apply again for a scholarship in a subsequent or later year.
- Application must be made on the Society's Scholarship application form and the all requested details must be provided, including an explanation as to their eligibility based on a demonstrated interest in agriculture and the desire to further expand their interest or involvement in the industry.
- The Scholarship committee will consider applications based on the information provided and will look to support passionate youth demonstrating or developing an interest in the agricultural industry. The committee's decision will be final.
- The successful applicants will receive a monetary sum paid directly to their educational institution towards payment of education expenses in their chosen discipline in the Agricultural industry. Education expenses may include but not limited to, Tertiary tuition fees, paying Higher Education Charges upfront or towards secondary school fees.
