# **Transit Retreat Overview**

The Transit Retreat is a unique national event that brings together public transit and mobility leaders from across the country for 2 days of sessions and networking. The Transit Retreat targets rural and small urban transit providers along with Federal Transit Administration Technical Assistance Centers, National Trade Associations and Vendor partners. This event is unique to the Transit industry as we specifically focus on rural and small urban providers and limit total attendance to 150 people to ensure a "small group" atmosphere conducive to conversation and networking.

NPMA is a non-profit organization that provides education and support for mobility projects in Northwest Pennsylvania. The Transit Retreat is an education fundraiser to support the mission of NPMA.

## Ideal Host City Requirements:

- 1. Location in small urban city under 250,000 population
- 2. Partnership with local public transportation provider to assist with shuttle service to offsite dinners or networking events
- 3. Location for Retreat accessible by public transportation
- 4. Location for Retreat within 30 minutes of Regional or International airport
- 5. Location with downtown venues (microbreweries, museums, etc) to accommodate dinner and networking events
- 6. Partnership with State DOT to support facility or training costs with RTAP funding
- 7. Partnership with local Visitors Bureau/Association to assist with promotion or support of Retreat
- 8. City/State that recognizes sales tax exempt status for out of state 501C3 organizations

### Facility Requirements:

- 1. Ballroom large enough to accommodate 150 people with round tables for lunch events
- 2. 2-3 break-out rooms to accommodate 75-90 people theatre style seating
- 3. Common area space to accommodate 20-25 vendor tables (6-8ft tables)
- 4. Walking distance from hotel(s) to offsite venue/downtown locations
- 5. Percentage of rooms at GSA Rate for overnight stays for qualifying attendees

### **Bed Night Requirements:**

Day before Retreat:	70 nights
Day 1 of Retreat:	110 nights
Day 2 of Retreat:	80 nights
