REFLECTION – REFLEXIÓN

John 1:29-34

“John testified further saying, ‘I saw the Spirit come down like a dove from heaven and remain upon him. I did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, ‘On whomever, you see the Spirit come down and remain, he is the one who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.’ Now I have seen and testified that he is the Son of God.”

As happened last week, we are still at the Jordan, observing the sign of the presence of the Spirit. Isn't it a powerful moment, when John the Evangelist in His first chapter quotes the Baptist saying, 'He is the Son of God?' The Baptist said he did not know Him. This is what we believe! How well do we know Jesus, not just about Jesus. Do I know Him as well as He knows me? Open the bible, read the word, join a discussion group. Jesus and His Spirit will join you.

Juan 1:29-34

“Y Juan dió este testimonio: ‘He visto al Espíritu descender del cielo en forma de paloma y permanecer sobre El. Yo no lo conocía, pero el que me envió a bautizar con agua me dijo: ‘Aquel sobre el que veas descender el Espíritu y permanecer sobre El, ese es el que bautiza en el Espíritu Santo.’ Yo lo he visto y doy testimonio de que El es el Hijo de Dios.”

Igual que la semana pasada, estamos aún en el Jordán, observando la señal de la presencia del Espíritu. ¿No es un momento poderoso, cuando San Juan Evangelista, en su primer capítulo cita al Bautista diciendo 'El es el Hijo de Dios.' El Bautista dice que no lo conocía. ¡Es lo que creemos! ¿Qué tan bien conocemos a Jesús, y no sólo sobre Jesús? ¿Lo conozco tan bien como El me conoce? Abra la biblia, lea la Palabra, únase a un grupo de discusión. Jesús y su Espíritu se le unirán.

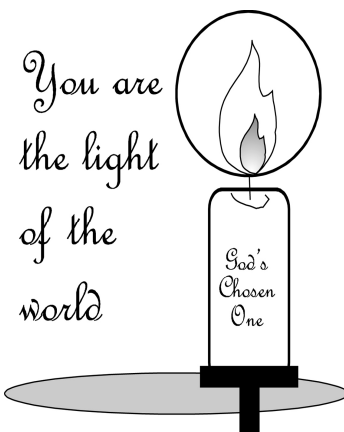
