REFLECTION – REFLEXIÓN

Matthew 3, 1-12

"Accept one another, then, as Christ accepted you, for the glory of God. Yes, I affirm that Christ, became the servant of the Jews because of God's faithfulness in fulfilling the promises of the patriarchs, whereas the Gentiles glorify God because of his mercy. As scripture has it 'therefore I will praise you among the Gentiles, and I will sing to your name.'"

We continue this season of anticipation and expectation. How special it is. Saint Paul reminds us of those in former times, how they longed for, yearned for the one who was to come as Messiah and Savior of us all. He later would tell us that we are no different, but all are one in Christ Jesus.

Today when there is such hate, division, and separateness, we need to seek Jesus who unites not divides. May this be part of our advent prayer this week.

'Come Lord Jesus.'

Mateo 3, 1-12

"Sean mutuamente acogedores, como Cristo los acogió a ustedes para la gloria de Dios. Porque les aseguro que Cristo se hizo servidor de los judíos para confirmar la fidelidad de Dios, cumpliendo las promesas que él había hecho a nuestros padres, y para que los paganos glorifiquen a Dios por su misericordia. Que sea parte de nuestra oración de adviento de esta semana.

As you light the Advent candles, use these prayers to invite

hope, peace, joy, and love in your home during this
sacred season.

Week 1: Hope

As you light the first purple candle, say:

"Dear Jesus, you are the hope in our messy world. This Advent, help us slow down, listen to your voice, and focus on what's important. We place our hope in you as we prepare our hearts to celebrate your birth on Christmas. Amen."

As you light the second purple candle, say:

"God of light, as we wait through the long winter nights for the birth of Christ, help us to keep watch. Help us to tend the tiny flame of hope. Make us alert until your gift of joy arrives. We ask this through Christ, our Lord. Amen."

Directions

- [1] Color the tree green, write your good deeds on the ornaments and color them in.
- [2] Cut out and fold at right angle to stand up by itself.
- [3] Each week of Advent complete the tree and repeat steps 1-2.
- [4] After you have 4 weeks of trees colored, filled in and cut out, attach **week 1** to **week 2** by matching the corner letters and gluing or taping halves together up to the fold line. Do the same for **week 3** and **week 4**, which will then attach to **week 1** and **2** to complete.

Color tree and fill in good deeds, then color ornaments and cut out.

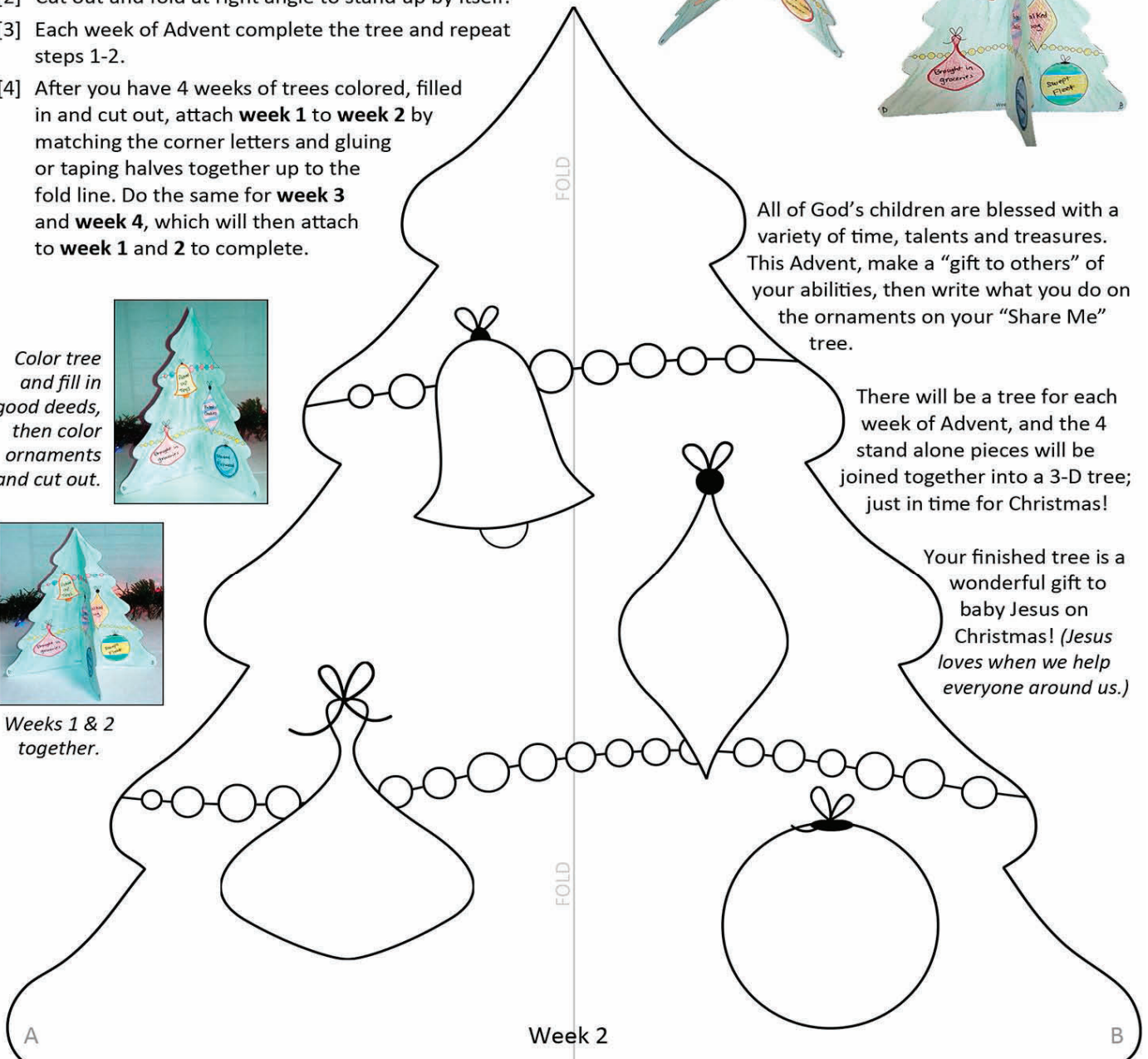
Different angles of completed tree.

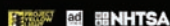
