REFLECTION – REFLEXIÓN

John 7: 37-39

“Thus says the Lord: I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh. Your sons and daughters will prophecy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions, even upon the servants and the handmaids, in those days, I will pour out my spirit”... “In the same way the Spirit too comes to the aid of our weakness, for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes with inexpressible groanings.”

We can spend our time recalling the Pentecost event in Jerusalem and the effect it produced for the first followers of Jesus. It provides the answer to the question ‘How did our church get its start?’ After two thousand years it is the same Holy Spirit present to us today, filling us, guiding us, in the way of salvation.

What is the difference? We often fail to call upon the Spirit to give life to our faith, to guide us in His way, to touch the lives of our needy world. When we pray for the Holy Spirit, we affirm that it is the Spirit who will renew the face of the earth. We are the instruments God wishes to use to let this happen.



Juan 7, 37-39

“Dice el Señor, derramaré mi Espíritu sobre todos los hombres y profetizarán sus hijos y sus hijas; los jóvenes verán visiones y los ancianos tendrán sueños proféticos. Más aún, derramaré mi Espíritu sobre mis servidores y servidoras, y ellos profetizarán ... Igualmente, el mismo Espíritu viene en ayuda de nuestra debilidad porque no sabemos orar como es debido; pero ese Espíritu intercede por nosotros con gemidos inefables.”

Podemos seguir recordando el evento de Pentecostés en Jerusalén y el efecto que produjo sobre los primeros seguidores de Jesús. Responde a la pregunta ¿Cómo se inició nuestra Iglesia? Después de dos mil años, el mismo Espíritu Santo sigue presente, llenándonos, guiándonos al camino de salvación.

¿Cuál es la diferencia? A menudo olvidamos pedir al Espíritu que dé vida a nuestra fe, a guiarnos por Su camino, a cambiar las vidas de nuestro mundo necesitado. Al orar al Espíritu Santo, afirmamos que es El quien renovará la faz de la tierra. Somos instrumentos que Dios desea utilizar para que esto suceda.

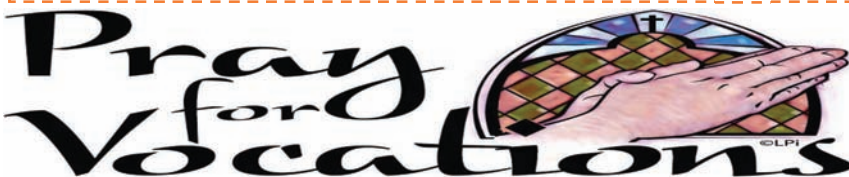

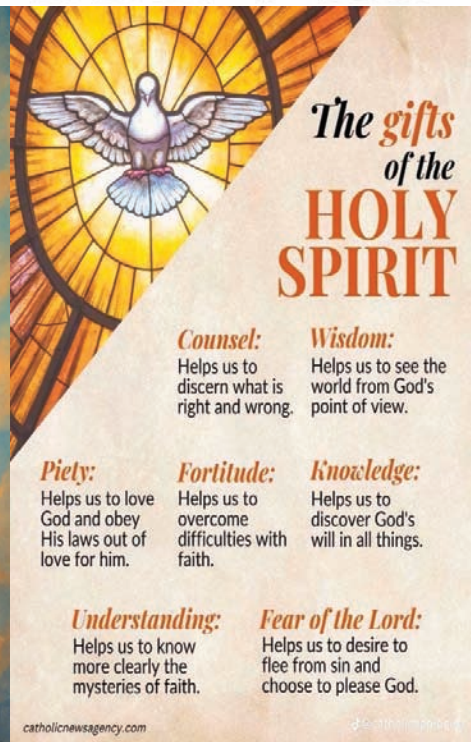

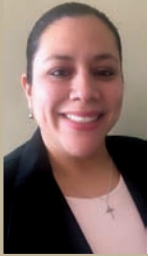
