Banks tops NAL hitters; Jones' 98 whiffs high

CHICAGO — Jim Banks of Memphis still heads the batters in the Negro American League with a mark of .443, according to Howe News Bureau statistics.

The other positions among the top quintet of batters are occupied by the same players with Isaac Barnes, also of Memphis holding down a .329 figure, Ira M. Knight of Kansas City .328, Bill Wyatt of Birmingham .321 and Lonnie Harris of Memphis .310.

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ABDEL JOHNSON of Detroit has the most hits, 50, while

Kansas City Sam Allen has the most bases 79, and runs scored 43. Banks is tops in doubles with 12 and runs batted in with 37, and is tied with Allen for the lead in homers with 5 apiece.

Bill Mitchell of Birmingham and Frank Marsh of Kansas City are tied for the lead in triples, each with four. Bob Wilson of Kansas City has stolen the most bases, 25.

Bill Jones of Kansas City has won the most games, 10. He also has worked the most innings, 110, and has struck out the most batters, 98.
