

Texas-Louisiana Negro League (1930)

It was common practice for the teams in the league to all play a different number of games during the season.

The following Texas-Louisianan League standings were published in the Chicago Defender on July 12, 1930.

The Houston Chronicle reported that the San Luis Cubans from Mexico played at least part of the second half of the season in the “league.”

The Texas-Louisiana League concluded play on August 15th.

The Houston Black Buffaloes won both halves of the season to capture the Texas-Louisiana League title.

Texas-Louisiana Negro League (1931)

It was common practice for the teams in the league to all play a different number of games during the season.
