The staffs at MBK Solicitors have completed the Online Solicitor's Regulation's Authority's Diversity Questionnaire in July 2025.


We have received a 100% response to the survey.

#### What is your ethnic group?




#### Gender breakdown as a percentage of all staff by different role category

# Breakdown by sex as a percentage of all staff with the roles reduced to one category







### Do you consider yourself to have a disability according to the definition in the Equality Act 2010?



## Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?












# Occupation of employee's main household earner at 14 years of age






Did either of your parents attend university and gain a degree (eg BA/BSc or equivalent) by the time you were 18?
