The committee meeting of the Laureldale Borough Council was called to order at 7:00 PM by Council President, Rick Heffner. The following council members were present: Janet Hess, Jeff Calpino, Bethany Pursell, Heather Sustello, Dean Borrell, and Beth Young. Also present were Borough Manager Josh Levengood, Mayor Donald Raifsnider, Jr., Solicitor Alex Elliker, Public Works Supervisor Bill Kutz, and Police Chief Brian Horner.

The following issues were discussed.

1. Bill Kutz updated council on the status of the sewer and water extension project at Dominic Manzella Park. Elizabeth Ave. has been repaved, curbs have been restored, along with grass seeding at Manor Care.
2. Bill Kutz updated council on the status of the Muhlenberg School District sewer line replacement project. 200 feet of main sewer line has been installed.
3. Alex Elliker reported that there are no further updates on the intermunicipal agreement with Alsace Township and Mount Penn. We are still waiting on both the township and borough.
4. Borough Council discussed and agreed to cancel the Council meeting scheduled for 7/14/2025.
5. Janet Hess will be making a motion to make repairs to streets department truck for a cost of approximately \$1600 plus shipment.
6. Heather Sustello will be making a motion to accept the resignation of Thomas Schmoyer effective June 13, 2025.

Borough Council then went into an executive session at 7:09PM to discuss personnel and real estate issues.

Borough Council re-entered into public session at 8:08PM.

Motion by Jeff Calpino and seconded by Heather Sustello to amend resolution 2025-08 to include that any proposed overtime must be approved by the Council President or Borough Manager. Carried.

7. Heather Sustello will be making a motion to accept the agreement for the Rail Trail deed transfer.

Borough Council then went back into executive session at 8:12PM.

Borough Council re-entered into public session at 8:21PM.
