The committee meeting of the Laureldale Borough Council was called to order at 7:00PM by Council President, Rick Heffner. The following members were present: Jeff Calpino, Janet Hess, Nytza Santiago, Heather Sustello, and Dean Borrell. Also in attendance were Borough Manager Josh Levengood, Street Supervisor Bill Kutz, and Solicitor Alex Elliker.

The following issues were discussed.

1. Alex Elliker updated council on the Muhlenberg school district projects. Dean Borrell will be making a motion to approve the memorandum of understanding with the School District regarding emergency response procedures.
2. Jeff Calpino will be making a motion to sponsor Albright Center of Excellence in Local Government for \$250.
3. Josh Levengood updated council regarding the Rosedale Playground Grant Application.
4. Nytza Santiago will be making a motion to advertise the Chapter 20 Trash and Recycling Ordinances to comply with the 902 Recycling Grant requirements.
5. The City of Reading has submitted the reconciliation for 2024. Jeff Calpino provided council with the details of this.
6. Borough Council has agreed to use the digital sign to thank businesses who sponsor Borough events.
7. Calvary Lutheran Church is looking to use the pavilion at Dominic Manzella Park for the morning of June 14<sup>th</sup> from 8AM till 12PM. Due to the ongoing construction at the park, Council will be offering the use of the Rosedale Playground at a cost of \$100.
8. Council discussed whether to hold Sundaes in the Park at Dominic Manzella Park or Rosedale Playground. Further discussion and decision will be made at the May Council Meeting.
9. Nytza Santiago will be making a motion to purchase a 4-gas confined space meter for the sewer department in the amount of \$1746.10 to be paid from the sewer account.
