## Short Term Rental/B&B

Short-term rental (STR) owners and guests are advised that boat launch and parking passes are strictly non-transferable. Enforcement of this policy, including authentication of addresses will ensure compliance. Using false or transferred credentials may result in denied access.

## Eugenia Lake Boating Rules & Code of Conduct

### Boat Launch Hours of Operation

Boat launch is staffed from Victoria Day weekend until September 30. Fees are payable before launching or upon return. Boats must be out of the water before closing.

### Boat Launching

All boats arriving on a trailer must be launched from the boat ramp. No launching fee for non-motorized boats. Car-top boats may be walked down to the water at any location but must yield to and be ever-mindful of swimmers.

### Boat Launch Registration

All boaters with trailers must register with the boat launch attendant at the booth near the entrance to the parking area. All boaters must present a valid Ontario Pleasure Craft Operator Card and must be aware of and abide by Ontario Boating Regulations. All boaters must follow proper boat launch etiquette on a first come, first served basis. Please no line-jumping. Please be quick and efficient getting your boat in and out of the water.

### Trailer Parking

No parking of vehicles or trailers at the launch entrance. Vehicles and trailers must park in the designated parking areas. Overflow parking is along the east side of Evans Ave.

### On the Water

Depart from boat ramp straight out into Lake; approach boat ramp straight on. Motorized boats are not allowed in or near the swimming area. Please always be mindful of swimmers. Please no wake. Observe 10km/hr limit within 100 ft of shore.

### Environmental Stewardship

No littering allowed. While visiting our lake, please keep the lake, dock and picnic areas clean. Put garbage in trash cans provided. No bait-dumping. To help contain the spread of zebra mussels, please clean your boat between outings.

### Boating Safety Equipment Requirements

Boaters require Ontario Pleasure Craft Operator Card and marine safety equipment. Always have with you:

- Canadian-approved flotation device or life jacket of appropriate size for each passenger on board
- Buoyant heaving line at least 15 m in length
- Watertight flashlight OR Canadian approved flares – Type A, B or C
- Sound-signaling device
- Manual propelling device (i.e. paddle) OR an anchor with at least 15 meters of rope, chain or cable
- Bailer OR manual water pump
- Class 5 BC fire extinguisher

Recommend items – enough supply for everyone on board:

- Marine First Aid Kit
- Drinking water
- Sun-screen
- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Dry clothing (i.e. long-sleeved shirt)
- Snacks
- Waterproof matches
- Knife

### Alcohol/Code of Conduct

Wait until you are off the water before consuming alcohol. Remember, if you drink, be sure you have a designated driver for your vehicle. Don't allow a person who has consumed alcohol to operate a boat. Please be responsible!

Always treat staff/other boaters with kindness and respect!

### Weather Conditions

Plan ahead! Check weather sources for up-to-date information.

### Fishing/Camping

Practice catch-and-release. Please no live minnows as bait. No smoking, fishing from dock area, overnight docking/parking, camping or campfires allowed.

**Note: Pull boat to end of the dock and completely free of trailer before starting motor. Similarly, shut motor off before putting boat onto your trailer.**
