- enjoys and shows a real interest in learning, manifested both academically and outside of school;
- possesses a sense of humor, and can enjoy a laugh at his or her own expense;
- cares passionately about issues of fairness;
- cares deeply for family and friends.

The scholarship award may be used by the recipient for the student's tuition, room and board; costs and expenses related to travel; and/or the purchase of school supplies, books and/or a computer.

The John H. Smyth Scholarship Fund is administered by the Masterman School Foundation, a 501(c)(3) organization, and donations to the Fund will be tax deductible as charitable donations.
