#### Adult Hangouts

Evening hangouts for adults to foster real social connection via fun games and creative nights, field trips, and speakers. A safe, welcome space where adults with autism can thrive. Hangouts offered monthly in Naperville, check calendar for dates.

#### C.R.E.W.

A Community, Recreation, Engagement, and Well-being day program for young adults. Recreational and life-enriching activities, including movement and mindfulness like yoga, hands-on skills like cooking, and creative outlets such as art. Participants build confidence, independence, and lasting friendships in a safe, supportive environment. Meets weekdays with flexible scheduling. Registration required.

#### Employment Training Program (ETP)

Employment services equip job seekers with the skills to succeed — from resume building and interviewing to hands-on job coaching. Using the Customized Employment model, this individualized approach connects each person's unique strengths, interests, and goals to the right career fit.

#### Adult Enterprise Work Opportunities

On-site employment opportunities for adults with autism via enterprise programs and partnerships. Work includes distributing Turning Pointe's specialty coffee blend with Two Brothers Coffee Roasters, assembling and distributing Pumpkin Race kits, screen-printing and distributing Turning Pointe merchandise, and more. Enterprises provide meaningful, interesting paid work opportunities. \*All employees are paid hourly Illinois minimum wage.
