

This circular walk is the first marked walking trail supported by the Ynysybwll Regeneration Partnership.

The trail is about 3½ km long, (2¼ miles) and should take about 1½ hours. Parts of the trail is tarmac, and is signposted throughout.

Some of this trail goes along The Lady Windsor cycle way which is a permissive path, but the remainder are public rights of way maintained by the local authority.

The farm road is used by vehicles and other users including horses and dog walkers.

Gradients can be variable and may include some short steep sections.

The start and finish is at the Roberttown square, CF37 3HR, Grid ref. ST061 941

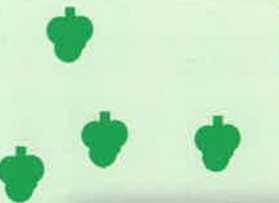
