Full name "nickname", age, residence of what city & state, date & place of birth, parents names (which could include mother's maiden name), marriage info., school and work history, hobbies, interest, passions, organizations, etc... names of survivors (spouse, children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, parents, sisters, brothers, other relatives), names of those that have preceded in death, visitation, funeral and burial info., information on a memorial if one is going to be established.
