1st place: \$100

2nd place: \$75

Awarded to “top 3” winners of each Class

Class 1: Up to age 10

Class 2: ages 11 – 13

Class 3: ages 14 – 18

1. The first “2” participants to secure and properly halter the Lamb (within the allotted time TBD) will win. ****MUST HAVE 5 PER CLASS OTHERWISE AGE GROUPS WILL BE COMBINED
2. Participants will be given a rope halter before entering the ring.
3. At NO time can the participant tie the rope halter to any part of their body, must carry in hand.
4. At NO time can the rope halter be used as a lariat. No pinning sheep against the fence.
5. If participant has hold of a lamb, NO other participant will be allowed to touch it unless it breaks free.
6. If 2 or more participants catch the same lamb, the lamb will be turned loose.
7. Participants must secure and properly halter the lamb (Judges discretion).
8. NO undue roughness or poor sportsmanship will be tolerated
9. IN CASE OF EXTREME HEAT, THE CONTEST MAY BE CANCELLED FOR THE WELFARE OF THE ANIMALS AND PARTICIPANTS. CONTEST OFFICIALS WILL MAKE THE CALL ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE START OF THE EVENT.
