- Deadline:** Until the sale is full! **First come basis!! No refunds if you cancel week of Sale!**
- Confirmation:** A text or email will be sent to you before the sale for confirmation in Sale. If you do not receive one, please call/text (320) 293-3177 to confirm.

- Check in with Gail C. or Candice H.
- You provide your own tables and chairs. There are none available! Setup @ 6:45 am.
- **ALL vehicles must be moved farther away from the front Sale Doors!!**
- **Park in back** where there are 5-7 spaces to unload and move your vehicles so others can unload theirs.
- Trailers can unload in front, **but then must park behind school** in parking lot that is off of Co. Rd. 37 between Bethlehem Church and School
- Anyone packing up and leaving early will not be accepted at future sales.
- All dealers have their own tax #/EIN #.
- **** Mail in or email registration and ST19 form. Need both forms for a spot in sale****
- **Make checks payable to: Maple Lake Chamber of Commerce.**
- Your signature indicates agreement to all regulations, and states that we are not responsible for loss, theft, or accident.
- Any property damage caused by the participant needs to be fixed at participant expense.
