DCC PARTY HIRE

STEP 1: REQUEST YOUR DATE

Email your preferred party date to coordinator@duntrooncommunitycentre.org.au. We will confirm availability and provide payment details, the centre hire form, and booking conditions.

STEP 2: SECURE YOUR BOOKING

Pay your 2025 DCC VIP Membership fee (\$35) and the centre hire fee (\$200 total: \$100 hire fee + \$100 refundable deposit) via EFTPOS or bank transfer. Return your completed hire form and signed booking conditions to the coordinator.

STEP 3: BOOKING CONFIRMATION

Your booking is confirmed! The coordinator will send you centre information a few days before your event.

STEP 4: AFTER YOUR EVENT

© Complete the close checklist provided. The coordinator will contact you to arrange your deposit refund.
