### **Lump Sum Exit Scheme**

As of 12 April 2022, the voluntary Lump Sum Exit Scheme is now open for applications. As set out in the government's Agricultural Transition Plan 2021 – 2024, we will offer



farmers who wish to leave the industry the option of taking a lump sum payment. This will enable those who want to leave the industry to be able to leave in a managed way. Once they have received a lump sum, they won't be eligible for any further Direct Payments (Basic Payment

Scheme payments or delinked payments) in England.

#### How to apply

Farmers will be able to apply from today, 12 April, up to and including 30 September 2022. Applicants then have until 31 May 2024 to transfer out their agricultural land where required. Alongside the Lump Sum Exit Scheme, Defra are eager to support new entrants coming into the industry, and more details will be available later in the year.








## Free drop in faecal egg counting sessions Wednesday 4th May.

Bring dung samples from your own farm to test and learn how to analyse a sample yourself. Guidance will be provided to show you what to look for and the results can be checked on the day to ensure accuracy. 
