



Application process

STEP 1	Basic qualification criteria (a) Student is a Canadian citizen and is a resident of the Ontario region for at least a year. (b) Is not in default of an OSAP loan or other grant.
STEP 2	Have experienced difficult family or financial situations The grant will consider any case where a student is struggling with a difficult family or financial situation.
STEP 3	Meet the foundation's qualifications on the need for financial assistance (a) Family income less than \$100,000, including attributable income.

Applicants will be required to write a short (500 words or less) essay describing their loss and the impact it has had on theirfamily along with a description of their schooling.

DETAILS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP/BURSARY For successful candidates, Roots for Youth will provide the following financial contributions: Fall semester tuition, up to \$10,000 (at the discretion of the Board) will be paid for directly by Roots for Youth to the candidate's post-secondary institution. Upon proof of full-time registration for the winter term, Roots for Youth will pay for the candidate's winter semester tuition, up to \$10,000 (at the discretion of the Board), directly to the candidate's post-secondary institution. As an incentive to achieve greatness, if the student proves that in the fall semester of studies an average of 80% or higher under a full-time course load, the Board could grant an additional \$2,000. The additional grant would be paid in mid-January and the use of funds are not restricted. Should at any time, the student drop out of school, any recoverable tuition fees would be returned to Roots for Youth. The receipt of OSAP, other government based funding, other bursaries or scholarships, does not impact funds receivable from Roots for Youth.
