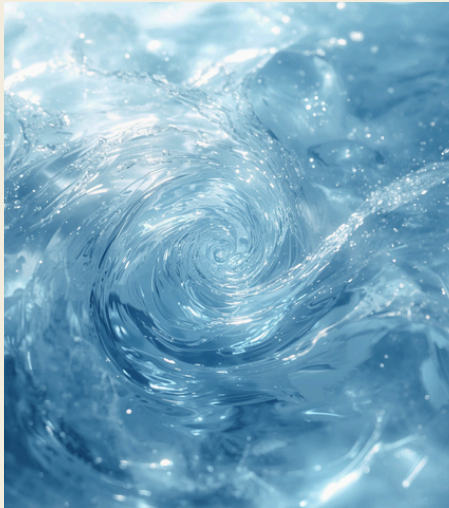

Held amidst the sacred, ancient temple landscapes and living waters of Siem Reap, this immersive eight-day journey brings together spiritual leaders, social entrepreneurs, peacebuilders, and cultural visionaries.

This is not a traditional gathering. It is a living field of relationship, creativity, and shared purpose—designed to build the deep human coherence needed to carry meaningful, transformative work into 2027 and beyond. Our home for this journey is the beautiful **Angkor Grace Wellness Resort**, an intentional sanctuary that perfectly mirrors our path from inner stillness to collective awakening.



The Two-Fold Journey: Yin & Yang

Our immersion unfolds in two intentional, flowing movements. We recognise that true, impactful global action cannot be born from exhaustion—it must arise from a place of deep inner alignment and restoration. Throughout the Convergence, participants will engage not only in strategic collaboration, but also in rekindling of collective imagination and the deeper fire of service.



Phase I: The Yin Movement — Sacred Waters & Deep Renewal January 3–6 | Honouring the Element of Water

The opening days of the Convergence are timed to coincide with the global 7 Days of Rest—an international annual invitation into reflection, healing, and planetary pause. This first half of our program is deeply yin in nature, inviting you to slow down, drop into the heart, and listen to the deeper currents moving through our world.

- **The Sacred Water Energy:** Water is central to the spirit of this phase. For the ancient Khmer civilization, water was ecological, cosmological, and deeply alive. We will immerse ourselves in these traditions through sacred temple pilgrimages, sound healing, meditation, and peaceful moments of deep listening.
- **Satsang & Meditation with Sadhviji:** Joining us straight from the banks of the sacred Ganges River in Rishikesh, India, revered spiritual leader **Sadhvi Bhagawati Saraswati (Sadhviji)** will bring her luminous water energy to our circle, guiding us through profound satsangs, meditations, and spiritual dialogues.
- **Sound Healing & Sanctuary:** Experience deep cellular restoration through the sublime vocal and instrumental soundscapes of international visionary artist **Kristin Hoffmann**. Our journeys will take place in the dedicated Amazing Grace Crystal Sound Temple at Angkor Grace.
- **Nourishment for Body & Spirit:** Between formal gatherings, you will have space to integrate, connect in intimacy, and enjoy the resort's premium wellness amenities, including full access to the Japanese-inspired thermal Onsen and yoga spaces.

Phase II: The Yang Movement — The Ancient Fire & Collective Action

January 7–10 | Honouring the Element of Fire

As the 7 Days of Rest reaches completion, the energy of our container naturally and dynamically shifts. We step out of the stillness of the waters and into the yang energy of the sacred fire—the element of insight, illumination, courage, and activation.

- **A Living Collaborative Forum:** This phase transitions our global circle into a high-vibrational, strategic forum focused on the year ahead for the worldwide movement for unity and peacebuilding.
- **Coherence in Action:** Together, we will step into co-creative design, strategic dialogue, alliance-building, and cross-sector networking. We will explore how to ground our shared visions into actionable grassroots initiatives across the globe.
- **Rekindling the Spark:** Guided by global changemakers, cultural pioneers, and strategic bridge-builders like **Charles Vogl**, this phase is about strengthening the trusted human tissue required to carry heavy planetary work. We gather not just to exchange intellectual concepts, but to ignite the collective imagination and the deeper fire of service.

The Angkor Convergence is conceived as part of a larger global movement seeking to help anchor 2027 as a pivotal turning point in human and planetary consciousness.
