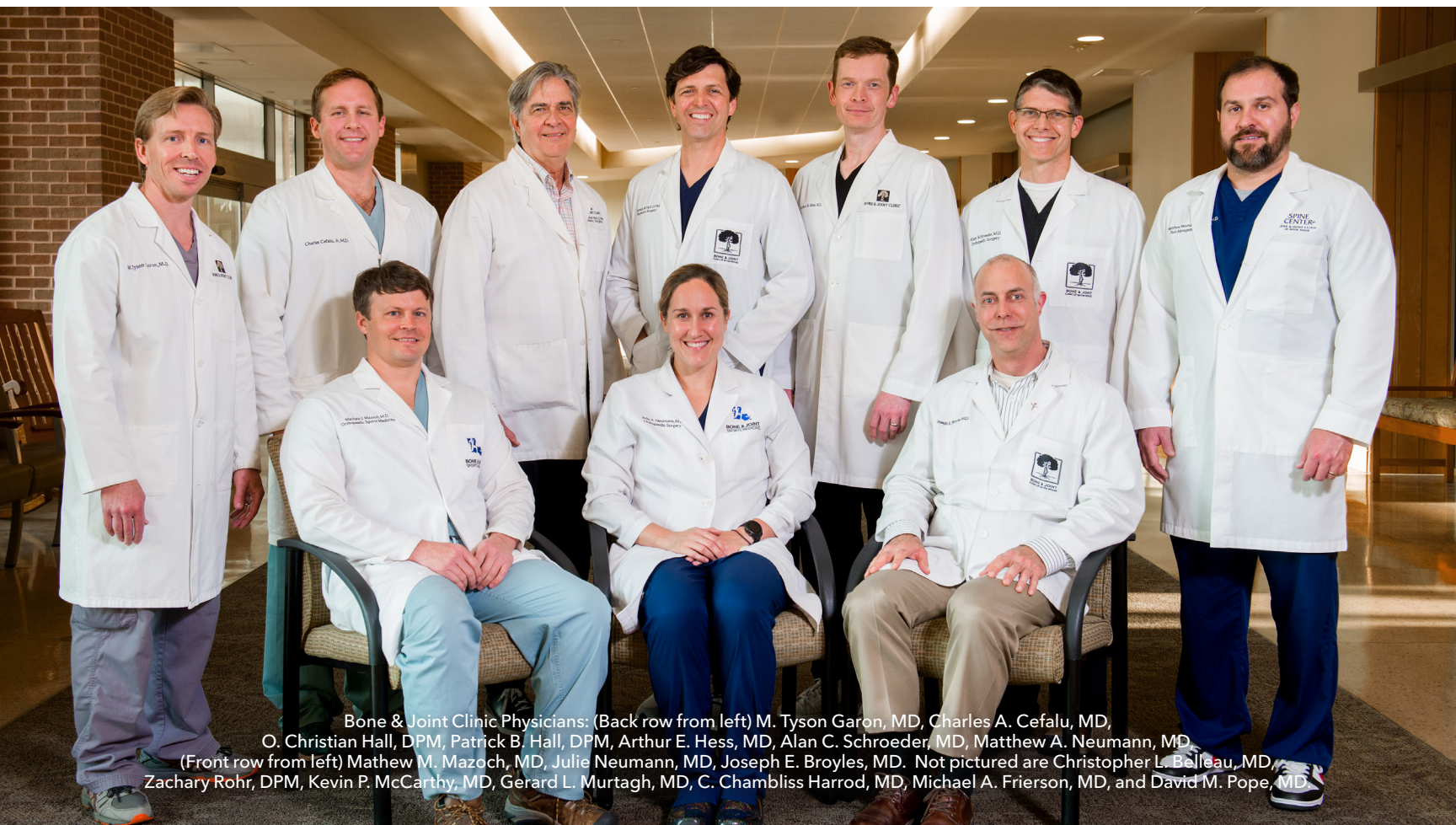
THE BONE AND JOINT CLINIC OF BATON ROUGE (BJCBR)

opened its doors in 1948 as the area's first orthopedic clinic, focusing on exceptional, dedicated orthopedic care from highly trained specialists. Seventy-five years later, that focus remains the same, and with the long-standing support of the community, the care has expanded greatly.

Today, BJCBR has five clinic locations in Baton Rouge, Brusly, Hammond, Prairieville, and Walker. It is home to nearly

200 specialized employees, including 17 orthopedic, pain management and podiatric specialists, nine licensed physician assistants, six licensed nurse practitioners, eight physical and occupational therapy specialists, certified orthopedic technicians, and radiological technologists. From initial exam and diagnosis to surgery, physical therapy and post-operative rehabilitation, BJCBR offers every orthopedic tool needed for patient success with a single provider.

BJCBR is a shining example of what it means to provide outstanding patient care, and no matter what the next 75 years may hold, that example will remain the same.
