

## Pacelines

Pacelines are a subset of drafting where the riders organize in closely spaced lines and focus on speed. Social interactions are limited. Pacelines are very much a part of riding with “A” level riders and race groups as well as some “B” level rides. “C” level rides offer opportunities to “get on someone’s wheel”, but this seldom ends up as a true pace line.

Knowing proper paceline techniques and etiquette are important for your safety and that of the other riders. A couple of videos that nicely illustrate pace line techniques are linked below.
