

HOW TO GET THE MOST OUT OF YOUR VINYL WRAP!



WASHING

Dirt and contaminants can stain your vinyl if not removed promptly. If the vehicle is driven often, we recommend washing at least every 2 weeks. Hand wash the vehicle using the 2-bucket method for the best results

- Hand-wash using gentle chemicals
- Avoid aiming the pressure washer at edges and corners
- Wipe away from edges and corners as opposed to towards them
- Use soft microfiber towels and wash mitts

Adding protection to your vinyl can help keep it looking it's best. An easy-to-use spray sealant such as Gtechniq C2v3 can provide good short-term protection. We always recommend a coating designed for vinyl such as Gtechniq Halo as it performs better and protects your vinyl longer.

INSPECTIONS

It's not uncommon for vinyl to require maintenance or replacements, especially if the vehicle is daily-driven. Check the film for rock chips or edges that may be lifting. Bringing the vehicle back to the installer to trim or replace the vinyl sooner than later may cut on the repair expense.

If your vinyl is reaching the end of its life, consider color PPF! Color PPF provides better protection, the highest longevity, a self-healing top-coat, and a gloss finish that's closer to paint than traditional vinyl.
