In the Youth Ministry and Confirmation process, we ask that each student/candidate complete twenty hours of service to the community each year. Through this experience, we hope that each student/candidate will discover the richness of ministry and, upon receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation, will feel called to continue living out their baptismal vocation through active service in the Church.

Each year, the student/candidate is required to complete a Service Hour Reflection Sheet for the service project(s) completed during that year. All service hours must be documented and submitted with the appropriate forms.

Service is about forming disciples who go forth to proclaim God's Kingdom in the world. Service projects should reflect the call to transform and enrich the larger community and world. The following is a list of ministries within our parish community in which you may choose to become involved:
