Sir Edmund Hillary epitomised the New Zealand spirit of adventure and he is our inspiration when planning your experience of a lifetime. We pay homage to Sir Edmund Hillary as we explore the South Island of New Zealand and experience the postcard perfect vistas and dramatic alpine scenery that this part of the world is renowned for.

Your guided journey begins in The Garden City, Christchurch, where you board one of the world's great train journeys, **The TranzAlpine** and traverse the majestic Canterbury Plains and Southern Alps via Arthur's Pass. Luxury coaches await in Greymouth to escort you to the glacial beauty of Franz Josef.

We then track inland to experience the wonders of Queenstown, Te Anau and Milford Sound. Cruise on the steamship **TSS Earnslaw** and ride the iconic steam train, **The Kingston Flyer**, the icing on the cake for railfans and historians.

A special journey is made to Waimea Plains Railway, home of the historic **Rogers K92** Steam Locomotive (the original Kingston Flyer) and the Croydon Aviation Museum.

Onward to Dunedin where we enjoy another iconic rail journey with **Dunedin Railways** through the remote and rugged landscape of the world-famous **Taieri Gorge**, an epic rail journey over white water rapids, towering viaducts and historic tunnels.

Our departure from Dunedin continues with

**Dunedin Railways** along the coastal route to Oamaru, then detours inland to “mountain country”, staying in Aoraki Mount Cook at the prestigious Hermitage Hotel with access to the Sir Edmund Hillary Alpine Centre, where you will banquet after a keynote presentation from a Hillary family member.

Back to Christchurch to join **The Coastal Pacific** Scenic Train, one of the most picturesque journeys on New Zealand's railways. Throughout this scenic experience, you will meander along the Pacific coast across remote beaches, between mountains and sea, on a timeless journey of breath-taking beauty to Kaikoura and onto Marlborough.

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

# 13-DAY TOUR DEPARTING CHRISTCHURCH

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Your journey begins in “The Garden City” Christchurch, where the iconic TranzAlpine awaits. Often regarded to be one of the world’s great train journeys for the scenery through which it passes. The journey is 223 kilometres one-way, taking almost five hours. You will see epic vistas, travel the edges of the ice-fed Waimakariri River, traverse the majestic Canterbury Plains and Southern Alps, and see vast stretches of ancient beach forest. Your guided tour is escorted by a fleet of luxury coaches that provide seamless transfers from the train to your accommodation each evening.

Arrive in Franz Josef, where an optional helicopter flight of the Franz Josef glacier is available for the adventurous.

Departing the West Coast, we will travel through the Haast Pass, journeying through large tracts of native rain forest and over the Southern Alps. This remote area has a ruggedly beautiful landscape of vast rainforests, gushing waterfalls and snow-capped mountains. Journeying through Makarora on the border of Mount Aspiring World Heritage Park, we pass by the crystal-clear waters of Lake Wanaka, Lake Hawea and Lake Dunstan. The adventure playground of Queenstown awaits. Cap off a special day as we take in The Remarkables Mountain Range and the view of Lake Wakatipu from the hotel. We join a lake cruise on board the historic TSS Earnslaw, the 1912 Edwardian steamboat, which takes us across Lake Wakatipu to Walter Peak High Country Farm for a gourmet BBQ lunch. Queenstown highlights include the historic and picturesque goldmining town, Arrowtown, on the banks of the Arrow River and taking in the Lakes District Museum.

We depart Queenstown to ride on the iconic Kingston Flyer Steam Train between Kingston and Fairlight. Then onward to the Fiordland National Park

district, where we pause to experience the wonders of Te Anau and Milford Sound. An optional alternative tour of Doubtful Sound is available.

From Te Anau, we continue to Mandeville, where we encounter the historic Rogers K92 locomotive, the original traction for The Kingston Flyer & explore the Croydon Aviation Museum, on our way to Dunedin. Whilst in Dunedin, we journey by rail over river gorges, towering viaducts and through a myriad of historic tunnels along the remote Taieri Gorge. Later we have the option to explore Larnach Castle and indulge in High Tea or visit the Tairaroa Head Albatross Colony, explore the hidden underground Fort Tairaroa and the worlds’ only Armstrong Disappearing Gun.

Arriving in Oamaru by Dunedin Rail, luxury coaches then provide the link inland to Aoraki Mt Cook, the tallest mountain in New Zealand - a familiar playground of Sir Edmund Hillary where he developed his climbing skills in preparation for the ascent of Everest. Highlights include a presentation from a guest speaker from the Hillary family, and a visit to Sir Edmund Hillary Alpine Centre.

Returning to the coast to Christchurch by luxury coach, your journey then connects with the spectacular Coastal Pacific Scenic Train onwards to majestic Kaikoura, where the great mountains of the Southern Alps rise from the deep trenches of the Pacific Ocean, home of the famed resident sperm whales.

Boarding the Coastal Pacific train again, we depart Kaikoura’s dramatic mountain backdrops onwards to the Marlborough winelands region. The coastal route heads inland, crossing the historic railroad bridge at Seddon and bursting out to the Awatere Valley, then through the Dashwood Pass to Blenheim. Explore the Omaka Aviation Heritage Centre, which features a world-class exhibition of WW1 & WW2 aircraft.

Continue to the harbour city of Wellington by charter flight, over the Queen Charlotte Sound and Cook Strait. Wake up in Wellington to spend the final day exploring the Museum of New Zealand Te Papa Tongarewa. Tour ends in Wellington.

## DAY 1

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### *Christchurch – Greymouth – Franz Josef*

Your journey begins at Christchurch Railway Station, where the iconic TranzAlpine awaits. Often regarded to be one of the world's great train journeys for the scenery through which it passes. The journey is 223 kilometres one-way, taking almost five hours. You will see epic vistas, travel the edges of the ice-fed Waimakariri River, traverse the majestic Canterbury Plains and Southern Alps, and see large tracts of native beech forest.

Luxury coaches await in Greymouth to transport you to your hotel in the ruggedly beautiful Franz Josef.

Passengers stay at the Scenic Hotel Franz Josef.



## DAY 2

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### *Franz Josef – Haast – Queenstown*

Wake up to enjoy the option for a helicopter tour of the Franz Josef glacier. Leaving Franz Josef, we travel down the West Coast through the Haast Pass, journeying through large tracts of native rain forest and over the Southern Alps. This remote area has a ruggedly beautiful landscape of vast rainforests, gushing waterfalls and snow-capped mountains. Continuing through Makarora on the border of Mount Aspiring World Heritage Park, we pass by the crystal-clear waters of Lake Wanaka, Lake Hawea and Lake Dunstan.

The adventure playground of Queenstown then awaits! Cap off a special day as we take in The Remarkables Mountain Range and the view of Lake Wakatipu from the hotel.

Passengers stay at the Novotel Lakeside Hotel in Queenstown, centrally located on the shores of Lake Wakatipu.





## DAY 3

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### *Queenstown*

Wake up to join a lake cruise on board the historic TSS Earnslaw, the 1912 Edwardian steamboat, which takes us across Lake Wakatipu to Walter Peak High Country Farm for a gourmet BBQ lunch.

Passengers stay again at the Novotel Lakeside Hotel in Queenstown.



## DAY 4

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### *Queenstown – Kingston – Te Anau*

Departing Queenstown, we continue to the village of Kingston which is nestled on southernmost end of Lake Wakatipu. Here, the iconic Kingston Flyer Steam Train awaits to take you on a memorable return journey between Kingston & Fairlight.

Then, we enter the Fiordland National Park district, continuing to traverse the Southern Scenic Route, our journey calls in to visit the Takahe Bird Sanctuary. Takahe are the stars of the show and meeting these prehistoric-looking characters is a 'must do' for Fiordland visitors. The sanctuary is a large part of the success of the Takahe Recovery Programme.

We spend an extended time experiencing the wonders of Te Anau and Milford Sound.

Passengers stay at the Distinction Hotel Luxmore in Te Anau.

## DAY 5

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### *Te Anau – Milford Sound – Te Anau*

Traveling along the Milford Road (between Te Anau and Milford) is one of the finest alpine drives in the world. The scenery is exceptional, ranging from broad grassy flats, dense rainforest and towering mountains through to glacial lakes and alpine herb fields. A day tour to Milford Sound offers some of the most spectacular natural scenery to be viewed anywhere in the world. Board the coach and travel through stunning scenery along the Milford Road and into Fiordland, where your cruise boat awaits you. The tour includes a cruise around the fiord so you can experience its wonders up close and see landmarks like Mitre Peak and amazing wildlife, such as dolphins and seals. Cruise the inner most reaches of Milford Sound to the open Tasman Sea and back (or there is the optional upgrade to explore Doubtful Sound instead).

A one-day itinerary is enough to see all the beautiful views along the way, take a scenic cruise around the fiord, and get back to Te Anau in time for dinner.

Passengers stay again at the Distinction Hotel Luxmore.



## DAY 6

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### *Te Anau – Mandeville – Dunedin*

Departing Te Anau for Dunedin, via Mandeville a special journey is made to Waimea Plains Railway, which is home of the historic Rogers K92 Steam Locomotive (the original Kingston Flyer) and we also explore the Croydon Aviation Museum.

Passengers will stay at Dunedin's premier luxury hotel, the Distinction Hotel, nestled in the heart of the city.



## DAY 7

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### *Dunedin*

In the morning, we explore the remote Taieri Gorge by Dunedin Rail over river gorges, weaving our way through a myriad of historic tunnels and guide you to the historic Wingatui Viaduct, a marvel of 1880s construction that remains the largest wrought iron structure in New Zealand.

An afternoon at leisure is planned or there are the optional excursions visit to Larnach Castle for a high tea & garden tour or explore the 'hidden' underground Fort Taiaaroa, located underneath the local Albatross colony.

Passengers stay again at the luxurious Distinction Hotel in Dunedin.



## DAY 8

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### *Dunedin – Oamaru – Aoraki Mt Cook*

Departing from Dunedin by rail, we continue to hug the coast towards Oamaru. We then detour inland via Waitaki Valley & Omarama by coach and onwards towards the spectacular Aoraki Mt Cook. Here, we find the home of the tallest mountain in New Zealand, which helped Sir Edmund Hillary to develop his climbing skills in preparation for the conquest of Mt Everest. Recognised as part of the Te Wahipounamu UNESCO World Heritage Area, the National Park is a breath-taking environment of glaciers, terminal lakes, turbulent rivers and Australasia's tallest peak, the mighty Aoraki Mt Cook soaring above at 3,724 metres. There is the option after dinner to enjoy star-gazing at the Planetarium, digitally immersed in what has been voted the world's largest "International Dark Sky Reserve".

Passengers stay at the iconic Hermitage Hotel with majestic mountain views of Aoraki Mt Cook.





## DAY 9

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### *Aoraki Mt Cook*

Enjoy a leisurely morning and then a visit to the Sir Edmund Hillary Alpine Centre, which is a tribute to New Zealand's global icon as well as discovering New Zealand's colourful transport, climbing and hotel history. Followed by an afternoon scenic drive through the National Park surrounded by the silent splendour of the Southern Alps. Morning optional activities include a glacier explorer cruise or a scenic ski plane flight with expert pilots navigating their way over the glacial lake, passing soaring mountain tops over NZ's longest glacier - the 600 metre thick, Tasman Glacier. Guest speaker is a Hillary family representative in the Sir Edmund Hillary Alpine Centre Theatre before dinner. The optional Planetarium Show takes place in the theatre after the Hillary presentation.

Passengers stay again at the Hermitage Hotel.



## DAY 10

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### *Aoraki Mt Cook – Geraldine – Christchurch*

A morning departure from the hotel leaving Aoraki Mt Cook by coach, we journey back to the coast via Tekapo, Geraldine and Rakaia on the way to Christchurch. On arrival in Christchurch, enjoy either a privately chartered Tram for a historic tram journey around the city or explore modern day Antarctica at the International Antarctic Centre and experience a taste of this unique and breathtaking continent – just like the explorers before you.

Passengers stay at the centrally located Distinction Hotel in Christchurch.





## DAY 11

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### *Christchurch – Kaikoura*

*“Where the mountains meet the sea”*

Departing Christchurch on the Coastal Pacific Scenic Train, our destination is Kaikoura, home of resident whales, where the guardians of the seas – the mountains of the Southern Alps – rise majestically from the deep trenches of the Pacific Ocean. Several different species of whale can be seen off the coast of Kaikoura at different times of the year, and most of the time, the huge resident Sperm Whales can be sighted. The ocean trench just off the coast means sperm whales are often seen close to shore.

Passengers will stay at the newly opened Sudima Hotel, taking in spectacular views of the Kaikoura Esplanade.

## DAY 12

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### *Kaikoura – Marlborough – Wellington*

This morning, we board the Coastal Pacific train again, departing Kaikoura’s dramatic mountain backdrops onwards to the Marlborough winelands region. The coastal route heads inland, crossing the historic railroad bridge at Seddon and bursting out to the Awatere Valley, then through the Dashwood Pass to Blenheim. Explore the Omaka Aviation Heritage Centre on arrival, which features a world-class exhibition of WW1 & WW2 aircraft or enjoy a Marlborough wine-tasting session at a local winery. Then, your charter flight awaits at Blenheim Airport to whisk you away to Wellington.

Passengers stay at the Rydges Hotel in Featherston Street, Wellington.



## DAY 13

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### *Wellington*

Wake up to the final day in the harbour city of Wellington with a leisurely morning visit to Museum of New Zealand Te Papa Tongarewa. Tour ends in Wellington. There is the option for post-tour accommodation at the Rydges Hotel (in Featherston Street).
