

Package prices include only the listed services and do not include merchandise (such as caskets and vaults), sales tax, cash advance items, or optional upgrades. You're welcome to add additional services or merchandise to any package; however, substitutions or removals do not reduce the package price.

Notes:

- Package pricing is valid only when both casket and vault are purchased through HeartLight Funeral Services.
- Additional charges may apply for services, visitations, or ceremonies held during evenings, Saturday, Sunday, or holidays. We are happy to accommodate your preferred schedule and will clearly review any applicable surcharges during the arrangement process.
- Transportation costs are included for locations within a 50-mile radius. An additional mileage surcharge applies beyond 50 miles.

Traditional Burial Service.....\$3,795

A full-service funeral including a private family or public visitation, a formal ceremony, and a graveside farewell (See detailed service breakdown on the next page)

Immediate Burial with Graveside Service.....\$1,995

Immediate Burial with No Services.....\$1,395

Includes transfer of Decedent from place of death, shelter, basic services of funeral director and staff, authorizations, local transportation to cemetery. Transportation to local cemetery is done at the discretion of the mortuary and cemetery at a non-disclosed time. This charge does not include dressing, casket, vault, visitation, or ceremonies.

CREMATION SERVICE PACKAGES

Our service packages are designed to simplify the planning process by combining the most commonly selected services for cremation. Package prices include only the listed services and do not include merchandise (such as cremation containers, caskets, urns, keepsakes, etc.), sales tax, or cash advance items (such as death certificates, permits, or obituary fees), or optional upgrades. Additional care fees apply for decedents over 300lbs. Removal of medical devices may also incur additional fees.

In the state of Utah, a certified copy of the death certificate, a cremation permit, and an alternative cremation container are required for cremation and are not included in the package price unless otherwise noted.

Notes:

- Package pricing is valid only when both the rental casket and urn are purchased through HeartLight Funeral Services.
- Additional charges may apply for services, visitations, or ceremonies held during evenings, Saturday, Sunday, or holidays. We are happy to accommodate your preferred schedule and will clearly review any applicable surcharges during the arrangement process.
- Transportation costs are included for locations within a 50-mile radius. An additional mileage surcharge applies beyond 50 miles.

Cremation with Traditional Funeral Service.....\$3,595

Cremation with Visitation.....\$3,195

A final farewell that includes a private family or public visitation followed by a cremation (See detailed service breakdown on the next page)

Cremation with Memorial Service.....\$2,995

A gathering to remember the Decedent without the body present, often held before or after cremation, focusing on celebrating their life and sharing memories (See detailed service breakdown on the next page)

Simple Cremation.....\$1,825

Cremation with a small private family visitation includes transfer of Decedent, local transportation, filing authorizations and permits, crematory fee, and portion of basic services of funeral director and staff

Direct Cremation.....\$1,575

Cremation with transfer of Decedent, local transportation, filing authorizations and permits, crematory fee, and portion of basic services of funeral director and staff. This doesn't include visitation and funeral or memorial service. (See FTC Disclosure on the next page)

FTC Disclosures:

The charge for a Direct Cremation includes removal of the deceased, local transportation, filing necessary authorizations and permits, crematory fees, and a portion of the basic services of the funeral director and staff. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to or following cremation.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are fiberboard.

UNDERSTANDING THE COST

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff.....\$1,185

In accordance with Utah funeral service standards, the Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff fee is a **required, non-declinable charge** that applies to all funeral arrangements—whether you choose a traditional service, cremation, burial, or transfer.

This fee covers the essential professional services and overhead required to coordinate any type of arrangement, regardless of the specific selections you make.

This fee typically includes:

- 24/7 availability to respond to initial calls
- Arrangement conferences with the family or responsible party
- Completion and filing of all legal documents, permits, and authorizations
- Placement of obituary notices
- Planning and coordination with cemeteries, crematories, vault providers, and other service partners
- Shelter and respectful care of the deceased prior to final disposition

Facility & Administrative Overhead includes:

- Facility maintenance, insurance, and utilities
- Office staff, secretarial, and administrative support
- Equipment, inventory, and compliance-related expenses

Note:

- Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff fee—or a portion thereof—is already included in all funerals, cremation, and alternative professional service packages.
- **Additional charges** may apply for services, visitations, or ceremonies held during evenings, Saturday, Sunday, or holidays. We are happy to accommodate your preferred schedule and will clearly review any applicable surcharges during the arrangement process.
- Transportation costs are included for locations within a 50-mile radius. **An additional mileage surcharge** applies beyond 50 miles.

Payment Options:

At HeartLight Funeral Services, we understand that making arrangements can feel overwhelming, so we strive to keep our payment policies simple, fair, and transparent. To keep our costs lower for everyone, all financial arrangements must be completed at least one (1) full day prior to services and merchandise delivery.

We accept the following payment methods:

- Cash, Personal Check, Cashier's Check, or Money Order
- Credit Card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover)
- Pre-arranged Funeral Plan with HeartLight Funeral Services
- Transferable Pre-funded Funeral Plan purchased from another funeral home
- Assignment of Verified Life Insurance Benefits (subject to provider approval; additional fees may apply)
- Third-Party Financing through Affirm (fees may apply)

Embalming Preparation.....\$895

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. However, it may be necessary if you choose certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with public viewing. If you do not wish to have embalming, you usually have the right to select arrangements—such as direct cremation or immediate burial—that do not require it. Any Decedent transported by common carrier (such as by plane or train) must be embalmed by a licensed embalmer in a manner approved by the Utah State Board of Embalming (Utah R436-8-2).
