NEGRONI TIME

For people who like their aperitifs bitter and their humour drier.

The Negroni was invented in 1919 at Caffè Casoni in Florence, Italy, by bartender Fosco Scarselli for his friend, Count Camillo Negroni. The Count requested a stronger version of the Americano cocktail, so Scarselli replaced the soda water with gin and added an orange garnish instead of the typical lemon. Other patrons soon began ordering the drink by the Count's name, leading to its permanent name.

SUPER TUSCANS

Because even Tuscany likes to break its own rules.



In the 1970s, Tuscan winemakers grew frustrated with the rigid Italian wine laws that stifled innovation, forcing them to include white grapes in red wines and restricting the use of international varieties like Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. In response, producers like Antinori and Marchese Incisa della Rocchetta told everyone to go jump and created their own high-quality wines outside the official "DOC" system, which were initially relegated to the lowest quality tier, but quickly gained a reputation for excellence. Wine critics dubbed these rebellious, high-quality wines 'Super Tuscans' because of their quality and huge success, which ultimately led to new classifications in Italy to recognize these innovative styles. Now they are a sought after superpower that can make your legs wobble!
