

WE ARE GROWING!





494 new households registered at Risen Christ since May 2022 - nearly triple the original count!

Infant baptisms grew from just 4 in 2019 to 17 in 2024 - and already 15 in the first half of 2025.

Becoming Catholic soared from 1 participant in 2019 to 20 in 2024 - with 22 already enrolled for 2025.

1,953 individuals were served from our **Mobile Pantry** from May 2024 to June 2025.

ROOTED IN CHRIST, RISING TOGETHER

Our capital campaign theme is *Rooted in Christ, Rising Together*, which speaks to who we are now and who we are becoming. We are firmly rooted in Christ and in the bonds of faith, love and community that have sustained our parish since its earliest days. These strong roots allow us now to rise – reaching out in welcome, reaching up in worship and reaching forward in growth.

A SACRED SPACE FOR ALL

Our sanctuary is where we come together to worship, to celebrate and to grow in community. Overflow seating and limited parking are signs of a vibrant, growing parish and a clear call to act. As our faith family continues to grow, so too must our space for worship.

From the very beginning, our sanctuary was designed with hope for the future. The original architectural plans allowed for future expansion, anticipating the day our needs would outgrow the current space. *That time is now.*

Our plan for expansion is a response to Christ's call to welcome all, to make room for one another and to worship together as one faith community.

Every component of this project – from seating capacity to restrooms and parking – has been thoughtfully designed to meet the needs of our growing parish while honoring our commitment to stewardship. This is not a wish list, but a carefully planned response to the growth we've already seen and the continued growth we are called to support.



Sanctuary Expansion: Addition of 198 seats and accessible entrance through expansion on the south side of the church


New Cry Room: A designated space with 34 additional seats for families with young children to participate in Mass comfortably

More Restrooms: Additional bathroom facilities to better serve our growing congregation*


Expanded Parking: Increased parking capacity, including additional handicap-accessible spaces, to improve accessibility and convenience for parishioners and visitors*

This project is a powerful living expression of our commitment to grow in faith and to serve future generations. With these improvements, we will continue to ensure that our church remains a sacred, inclusive and life-giving space for all who enter.

After extensive planning, consultation with architects and careful evaluation of every option, the total projected cost of this next phase in our expansion plan is \$6 million.

This figure is not aspirational. It reflects only the most essential elements needed to meet our community's immediate needs.

Thanks to good stewardship and prudent planning, we already have \$800,000 in savings to apply toward this project. Per diocesan policy, we can begin construction as soon as we have 70% of the cost pledged.



CONTINUING THE VISION

While this campaign focuses on expanding the south side of the sanctuary to meet our most immediate needs, the expansion of the north side, along with additional classrooms, an updated kitchen and more social space, remains an important part of our long-term master plan.

As our community continues to grow and as resources allow, we will revisit the north side expansion in the future, ensuring that our facilities continue to support the vibrant faith life and hospitality that define our parish.

Our goal is rooted in discernment and stewardship – a balance between visionary planning and financial responsibility. We believe we have set a goal that is both attainable and essential, one that we believe can be reached over the next three years through the prayerful generosity of our parish family.

This chart serves as a guide as you prayerfully consider your level of support over a **three-year period**. We encourage you to consider a 10% to 20% initial payment to begin your commitment. This will help us begin construction sooner.
