- 5. Ministry Team Updates
 - a. Finance: Scott
 - i. The committee meets every third Tuesday of the month.
 - ii. Discussed the front door and roof repairs that are needed at the Becker Campus. Clay to push for a resolution with BCI builders. Ask Ryan from BCI. We will move forward. Have not heard back from Clay yet. The plan is to get a bid, then get the permission from the diocese. We need to get this done this fall. Ideally we want it done before winter. The committee will meet in July to finalize the plans and hopefully get them submitted to the diocese so that work can begin.
 - iii. Discussed annual budget. Completed. Annual assessment from the diocese for 2025 did not change. The budget is showing a \$23,000 surplus for 2025 because of the sharing of the salary and housing expenses for Father Mike with St. Marcus.

Father will contact City Hall in Becker to see if we can use that space and Xcel Energy who uses parts of the Big Lake parking lot.
