OUR PROGRAM

Laurel Hall sets our kindergarten students on an exciting course of lifelong learning and passion for education. Our kindergarten curriculum combines the elements of a rounded education including the basics of reading, writing and math, along with several specialty enrichment classes. Talented, caring teachers create an environment where our students can learn, grow and develop a sense of belonging within a community. In kindergarten, our students participate in both individual and group activities to develop and refine their skills along with having time to explore play and creativity.

SPECIALTY CLASSES

At Laurel Hall, specialty classes are an integral part of the school experience, enriching the core academic day and supporting the development of the whole child. Beginning in Kindergarten, students rotate through a thoughtfully designed program that includes **Physical Education, Spanish, Music, Art, Technology, Littles Library, and Chapel**, each taught by a dedicated specialty teacher. Parents also have the opportunity to volunteer in Littles Library throughout the school year, further strengthening the connection between home and school.

ENCOURAGING KINDERGARTEN READINESS AT HOME

Independence: Practice zipping jackets, opening lunch items, cleaning up, and following simple routines.

Early Literacy: Read together daily, recognize letters (especially in your child's name), and encourage storytelling.

Early Math: Count everyday objects, identify shapes and colors, and play simple sorting or pattern games.

Social Skills: Practice taking turns, listening, sharing, and expressing feelings with words.

Fine Motor Skills: Strengthen hands through coloring, drawing, cutting, and playdough.
