




Half-Day Tour | City of David & Holocaust Memorial Available on: July 21 - 22 - 23, 2026 Scheduled Departure: 2:00 PM

During the days of the FMI All Worker Gathering in Jerusalem, this Half-Day Tour invites you to step into the ancient heart of the Bible and the living memory of God's people. We begin at the City of David, where King David established his kingdom and where Scripture comes alive through remarkable archaeological discoveries. We then visit Yad Vashem, Israel's national Holocaust memorial, to honour lives lost, remember God's faithfulness, and pray for peace and hope.

Jerusalem: City of David

Where Jerusalem's Story Began

Explore the oldest part of Jerusalem, where King David captured the fortress of Zion and made it Israel's capital. Excavations reveal layers of faith and history—palaces, fortifications, and water channels that speak of God's enduring promise.

"David captured the fortress of Zion — which is the City of David." (2 Samuel 5:7)

Hezekiah's Tunnel & Southern Steps

Walk where ancient kings and pilgrims once prepared their hearts for worship. Beneath the city lies Hezekiah's Tunnel, carved through solid rock to secure Jerusalem's water supply, leading to the Pool of Siloam, where Jesus healed the man born blind. Nearby, the Southern Steps mark the entrance to the Temple where countless worshippers—and Jesus Himself—once walked and taught.

"Go, wash in the Pool of Siloam... So the man went and washed, and came home seeing." (John 9:7)



Yad Vashem, Holocaust Memorial

A sacred place of remembrance and hope, Yad Vashem honours the six million Jewish lives lost during the Holocaust. Here we reflect on humanity, God's covenant with His people, and our call to stand for compassion and truth.

All half-day tours are prepaid and priced in USD.


Cancellations made up to 30 days prior to the scheduled tour date will receive a full refund.
