From the storied lanes of the Old City to the Western Wall and along the Via Dolorosa, we trace Jesus' final steps to the Holy Sepulchre and witness the living faith of generations. We conclude at the Garden Tomb, a serene place of worship and reflection.

Jerusalem Old City Quarters

A living tapestry of faith and history, Jerusalem's Old City unfolds within ancient walls through the Jewish, Christian, Armenian, and Muslim quarters. Here sacred traditions, ancient stones, and vibrant markets mingle, carrying the prayers of generations. At the heart stands the Western Wall, the last remnant of the Temple where countless believers have sought God's presence.

"My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations." (Isaiah 56:7)

Via Dolorosa & Holy Sepulchre

Trace the Via Dolorosa, the path where Jesus carried the cross to Calvary — a journey of suffering and redeeming love to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, long revered as the place of His crucifixion, burial, and resurrection, where the heart of the Gospel meets living faith.

"He himself bore our sins in his body on the cross." (1 Peter 2:24)

"Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; He has risen!" (Luke 24:5-6)



Garden Tomb

In this peaceful garden, many believers remember the empty tomb and rejoice in the hope of the risen Christ.

All half-day tours are prepaid and priced in USD.


Cancellations made up to 30 days prior to the scheduled tour date will receive a full refund.
