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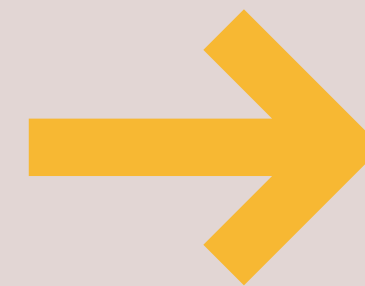

Jordan River Baptism Site

Pause at the Jordan River Baptism Site, where those who wish may enter the waters to experience baptism (optional), celebrated together with Foursquare Pastors—a sacred moment to renew faith and surrender to new beginnings. Sea of Galilee

Mount of Beatitudes

Here Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount, offering blessings that shape the heart of discipleship. In the peaceful setting of its octagonal basilica, the words of the Beatitudes still echo, calling us to live in the spirit of His Kingdom.

Tabgha

*"Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, He gave thanks and broke the loaves."
(Mark 6:41)*



Capernaum

"When Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to him, asking for help. 'Lord,' he said, 'my servant lies at home paralyzed, suffering terribly.' Jesus said to him, 'Shall I come and heal him?'" (Matthew 8:5-7).

DAY 2: Saturday, July 25, 2026

From the Shores of Galilee to Nazareth

Discover the sacred sites of hope and joy in faith.



Magdala

Mary of Magdala is remembered not only as a woman healed and set free, but also as the first witness to the resurrection—the messenger of the Good News.

The ancient synagogue dates to the very time Jesus taught in the region.

Cana

Remembered for the Wedding Feast where Jesus performed His first miracle, turning water into wine (John 2:1–11), Cana is also remembered as the place where Jesus later healed the son of a royal official.

“This, the first of His miraculous signs, Jesus performed in Cana of Galilee. He thus revealed His glory, and His disciples put their faith in Him.” (John 2:11)



Nazareth

Here Jesus grew up. We visit the **Basilica of the Annunciation**, built above the grotto where tradition holds that the Angel Gabriel announced to Mary that she would bear the Son of God.

“The angel went to her and said, ‘Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you.’” (Luke 1:28)

DAY 3: Sunday, July 26, 2026

From the Valley of Revelation to the Coast

Megiddo

Here, among palaces, stables, and ancient passageways, we will reflect on the rise and fall of kingdoms, and the unfolding story of God's plan.

"Then they gathered the kings together to the place that in Hebrew is called Armageddon."

(Revelation 16:16)

Caesarea Maritima

At Caesarea Maritima, the Gospel first reached the Gentiles when Cornelius the centurion received a vision and was baptized by Peter (Acts 10).

Later, Paul was imprisoned here and made his defense before King Agrippa (Acts 25), turning this coastal city into a powerful backdrop of faith and witness.



Old Jaffa

From Jaffa, Peter travelled to Caesarea to meet Cornelius, marking the first conversion of Gentiles and a turning point in the spread of the Gospel (Acts 10).

This humble coastal town became the doorway through which God revealed His plan for the nations.

DAY 4: Sunday, July 27, 2026

From the shores of Tel Aviv, we take with us the light of this journey—the moments that shaped our hearts. A farewell to the Holy Land, but not to the faith it rekindled within us.

03 **From 30 days prior to arrival or less**
A 100% cancellation fee will apply for the full amount of the booking, including accommodation and arrangements as per agreement.
