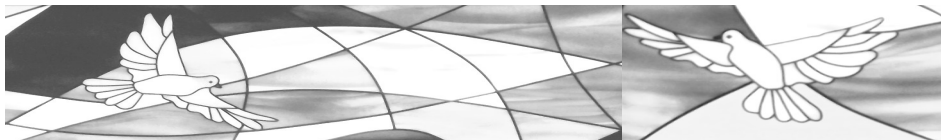

Jeremiah 28:5-9



Do not let sin reign in your mortal bodies, so that you obey their desires. For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace. When you were enslaved by sin, you had no righteousness. But now that you have been freed from sin and are now chained to God, the fruit you have leads to sanctification, and the end is eternal life. 


