† Fun Summer Catholic trivia: How well do you know St. Josemaría Escrivá? — *From his first confession to being the unofficial patron saint of diabetics, St. Josemaría will surprise you.* (Theresa Civantos Barber — Aleteia)

You've probably heard of Opus Dei, a Catholic organization whose mission is to spread the Christian message that every person is called to holiness and that every honest work can be sanctified.

But did you know its founder was a Spanish priest who is the unofficial patron saint of people with diabetes? And that's just the beginning of what might surprise you about this influential 20th-century saint.

St. Josemaría Escrivá is known for teaching that ordinary work can be a path to holiness, revolutionizing how Catholics today think about spirituality in daily life. But even if you're familiar with his famous teaching about finding God in your work, how well do you actually know this modern saint?

1. Where was St. Josemaría born?
2. When St. Josemaría was two years old, he became gravely ill. When he recovered, his mother made a pilgrimage in thanksgiving to what sacred site?
3. At his first confession, what funny penance did the priest assign St. Josemaría?
4. As a teenager, before he decided to become a priest, what career had he planned to pursue?
5. What did he see one day that inspired him to discern a call to the priesthood?
6. When and where did he receive the founding inspiration for Opus Dei?
7. How did Josemaría escape danger in the Spanish Civil War?
8. What was the first book St. Josemaría wrote, which became a spiritual classic?

9. How many years after his death was he canonized?
10. Fill in the blank: St. Josemaría taught that we should strive to become "\_\_\_\_\_ in the midst of the world"

### Answers:

1. He was born in Spain, in the city of Barbastro.
2. The hermitage of Our Lady of Torreciudad, located twelve miles from Barbastro. He later recalled that, seated on a mule and along rough roads, "My mother carried me in her arms to Our Lady."
3. To eat a fried egg
4. He had intended to be an architect.
5. At the age of 16, while walking on a cold winter day, St. Josemaría noticed footprints in the snow left by the bare feet of a Carmelite friar. As he considered the life of dedication represented by those footprints, he felt an awakening in his soul and wondered if he too was called to give himself to God.
6. On October 2, 1928, while in Madrid on a spiritual retreat, St. Josemaría envisioned "a mobilization of Christians of all walks of life who would make the world holy by offering to God their daily duties." From that day forward the young priest dedicated all his energies to this mission.
7. They crossed the Pyrenees mountains on foot, making a dangerous journey through Andorra to reach France.
8. The Way (Camino), a collection of 999 spiritual maxims first published in 1934
9. 27 years, as he died in 1975 and was canonized in 2002

## ST MARY'S SCRIPTURE STUDY LOOKS AHEAD TO ITS FALL SERIES



Propelled by the desire to explore their Faith and know God more deeply, members of St Mary's Scripture Study group have been participating in a guided program that examines the Word of God as revealed in the Old and New Testament. New participants are welcome.

The program consists of 8-10 week sessions in the Spring and Fall. Each cluster focuses on a particular theme. To date, these have included Mary: The Bible and the Mother of God, Eucharist: Discovering the Mass in the Bible, and most recently God: The Mystery of the Trinity in the Bible.

Each session lasts approximately one hour and consists of a 30-45 minute video lecture by Catholic biblical scholars, followed by an opportunity for brief discussion. The lectures are engaging, enlightening, and thought provoking. Although the sessions build upon one another, you do not need to attend every session to benefit. The program is not aimed at "Bible Scholars"; it is valuable for anyone who wishes to expand their understanding and increase their love of God.

Stay tuned for information about dates, times, and study topics for the Fall.

- "I was surprised to find that there was so much more depth to things that I had heard and read many times-- single words took on whole new meanings."
- "This class informed us about the connection between the Old and New Testaments, especially as the Old Testament predictions were fulfilled through Jesus."
- "I come because it breathes new life into my faith. It helps me realize how rich our Church history is."
- "I have learned that God is a mystery that we need to keep studying more."

**BAPTISMS:** Sundays at 12:15pm (excluding the 1st Sunday of each month). Please call the Rectory at least six weeks in advance to schedule your Baptism and to sign up for the Baptism Class that is required for both parents and Godparents. These classes are offered on the first Sunday of each month. Anyone requesting a Sponsorship form must be a currently registered and practicing Catholic, and they must attend one of the Baptism Classes to receive it. There is a 3-month waiting period for a sponsorship form for the newly registered. The Catholic requirements for a Godparent/Sponsor are: you must be at least 16 years old; received the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion and Confirmation in the Catholic Church; attend Mass regularly on Sundays and on Holy Days of Obligation; receive the Sacraments of Penance and Holy Communion regularly; sincerely try to follow the moral teaching of the Catholic Church; and if married, were married in the Catholic Church.




