

2023 Contributions to Saint Anthony of Padua Church Financial Request Form

The parish office needs at least ten (10) business day for your requests to be processed.

The parish office has until January 31, 2024 to process your request. If you submit your form after this date, then for example, if the staff receives your request on February 5, it will be available on or after February 19; if the request is submitted on February 12, it will be available on or after February 26. Keep this in mind when you choose to submit your financial statement request, especially if you need it for your 2023 income tax forms.

Financial Contributions Request for 2023

We do not list contributions or special collections without an envelope number. If you do not use your envelopes, we have no record of any donations you might have made.

NOTE: This statement will not include any contribution you might have made to the Bishop's Annual Appeal. That information may be obtained by calling the Diocese of Metuchen at 732-562-1990.
