



Did you know...



Saint Leo was born in Tuscany, Western Roman Empire. It was during Leo's papacy that "Pope" became to mean the Bishop of Rome in 440 AD. He assumed this role at a time of increasing barbarian invasions and decreasing imperial authority thereby taking an active role in public affairs.

His many sermons and writings were about theological questions concerning Jesus Christ and his role as mediator and savior. Leo worked for the propagation of the faith defending the true divinity and humanity of Christ.

He wanted to be buried close to Saint Peter, so upon his death in 461, he became the first Pope to be emtombed within the Old Saint Peter's Basilica. In 688, Pope Sergius had his remains moved to inside the basilica.

Centuries later, Pope Benedict XIV proclaimed Leo a "Doctor of the Church".
