Before You Start: Set Yourself Up for Success

- ✓ Update Your LinkedIn Profile Add your internship role and organization.
- ✓ **Announce Your Internship** Share your excitement and start building your network!

1. Start Strong: First Impressions Matter

- Be proactive—introduce yourself to your team and ask about expectations.
- Show enthusiasm and curiosity—ask questions and take notes.
- Learn workplace norms—observe communication styles and schedules.

2. Set Goals & Track Your Progress

- ✓ Identify 2-3 key skills or experiences you want to gain.
- Regularly check in with your supervisor for feedback.
- Keep a log of your accomplishments, projects, and key learnings.

3. Build & Expand Your Network

- **✓ Connect Laterally** Build relationships with fellow interns; they are future colleagues!
- **Engage Within Your Organization** Attend team meetings, introduce yourself, and connect with professionals in different departments.
- ✓ Find a Mentor Seek advice and guidance from someone experienced.
- Stay in Touch Connect on LinkedIn and follow up with a thank-you note.

4. Show Initiative & Solve Problems

- Look for ways to contribute beyond assigned tasks.
- Offer solutions when you encounter challenges.
- Ask for more responsibility if you're ready to take on more.

5. Communicate Effectively

- Keep your supervisor updated on your work and progress.
- Ask for clarification when needed—don't assume.
- Maintain a professional tone in emails and messages.

6. Reflect & Articulate Your Experience

- Translate your internship into resume bullet points (use action verbs!).
- Prepare a short "elevator pitch" about what you accomplished.
- ✓ Identify transferable skills—teamwork, problem-solving, adaptability.

7. Plan Your Next Steps

- Request a final feedback session before your internship ends.
- Express interest in staying connected or future opportunities.
- ✓ Continue developing the skills you learned—apply them in classes or jobs.
