This buys you one membership number (which we will allocate and enters you into the monthly draw). All participants must be over 16. If you would like more than one number please indicate this on the membership form and adjust your payment accordingly.

The draw will take place on 1st Tuesday of each month.

If you win, a bank transfer will be sent directly to you and the name of the winners published on our Group Facebook page and the Group website.

The prize money will be approximately 33% of the membership fee taken each month. The balance goes to the Group be used towards the upkeep and improvement of the Scout Headquarters. There will be four prizes each month of £50, £25, £15 and £10.

100 club rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 club is to raise funds for 1st Shelford & East Bridgford Scout Group. The money will be paid into the 1st Shelford & East Bridgford Hut Account and used to maintain and improve our headquarters. It will also enable us to build up reserves should any major works be required in the future.

Rules

1. For a cost of £3 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100. Should you require more than one entry then you will be allocated additional numbers.
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prize.
3. The prizes will total approximately 33% of the monthly income.
4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of £50, 2nd prize of £25, 3rd prize of £15 and 4th prize £10 for 11 out of 12 months. The prizes for December will be higher with a 1st prize of £70, 2nd prize of £40, 3rd prize of £20 and 4th prize of £15.
5. The 100 club is a private lottery and is open to all leaders, trustees, helpers, parents, carers and friends of 1st Shelford & East Bridgford Scout Group. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
6. Payments must be made by standing order (preferably annually) or monthly. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
7. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
8. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
9. The draw will be made at the Explorer Scout meeting on the 1st Tuesday of each month.
10. All winnings will be sent directly to your bank via bank transfer within one week of the draw.
11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the Group Facebook page, on the Group website and on the notice board in the Scout HQ.
12. The 100 club will be run by the Group Board of Trustees. In case of any dispute the decision of the Trustees is final.
