The Table of Duties: To Bishops, Pastors, and Preachers

1st gr+ The overseer must be above reproach,
The husband of but one wife,
Temperate, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach,

2nd gr+ Not given to drunkenness,
Not violent but gentle,
Not quarrelsome,
Not a lover of money.
He must manage his own family well
And see that his children obey him with proper respect. (1 Timothy 3:2-4)

3rd gr+ He must not be a recent convert,
Or he may become conceited
And fall under the same judgment as the devil. (1 Timothy 3:6)

4th gr+ He must hold firmly to the trustworthy message as it has been taught,
So that he can encourage others by sound doctrine
And refute those who oppose it. (Titus 1:9)

Here is a short order you may follow for family devotions around the dinner table or in the living room.

Invocation - In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit - **Amen.**

Recite - the Apostles’ Creed and the Learn-by-Heart Bible Verse & Catechism

Read and Discuss - one of the Scripture readings from this past Sunday, from school, or the coming Sunday

Pray - the Lord’s Prayer, Luther’s morning or evening prayers, and the topical prayers for the day of the week

Sing a hymn - use one of the hymns from the past Sunday, the coming Sunday, or the school year

Benediction

L: Let us bless the Lord.

C: Thanks be to God.

L: The Lord bless us, defend us from all evil, and bring us to everlasting life.

C: Amen.
