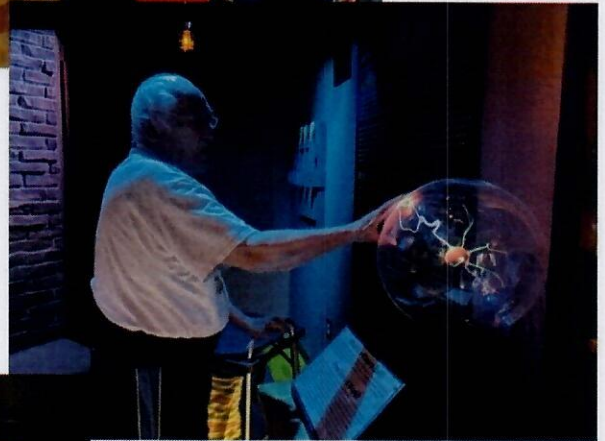
Thank you to the Chapman Fire Department for helping all of our staff learn the importance behind fire safety!

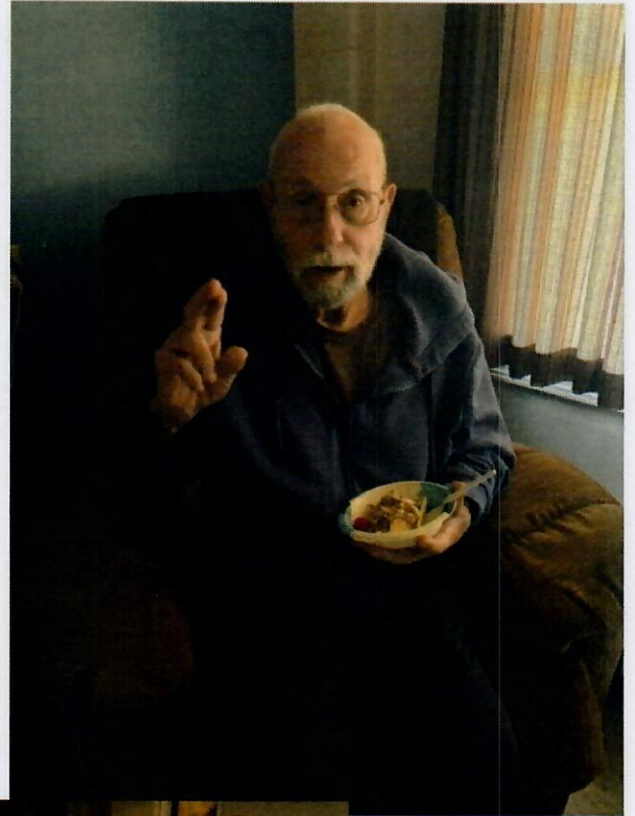

Resident Fun!

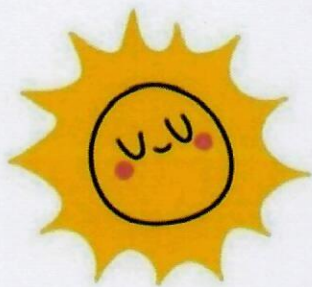

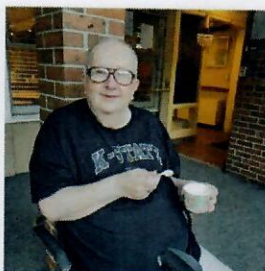
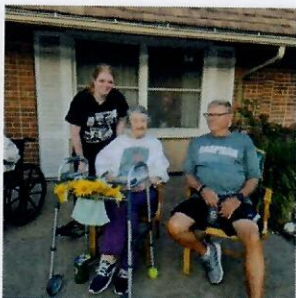
Celebrating a Well-Earned Retirement!
