“Books, backpacks, and big smiles – school spirit lives on at every age!”

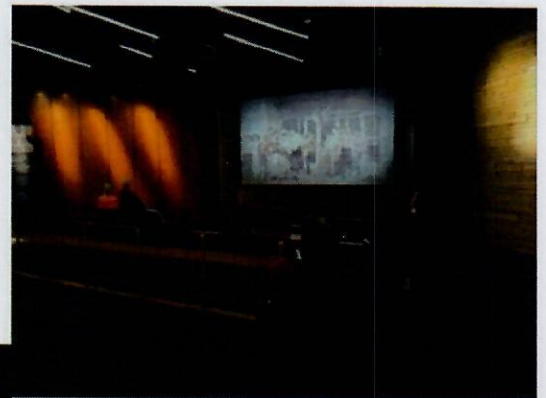

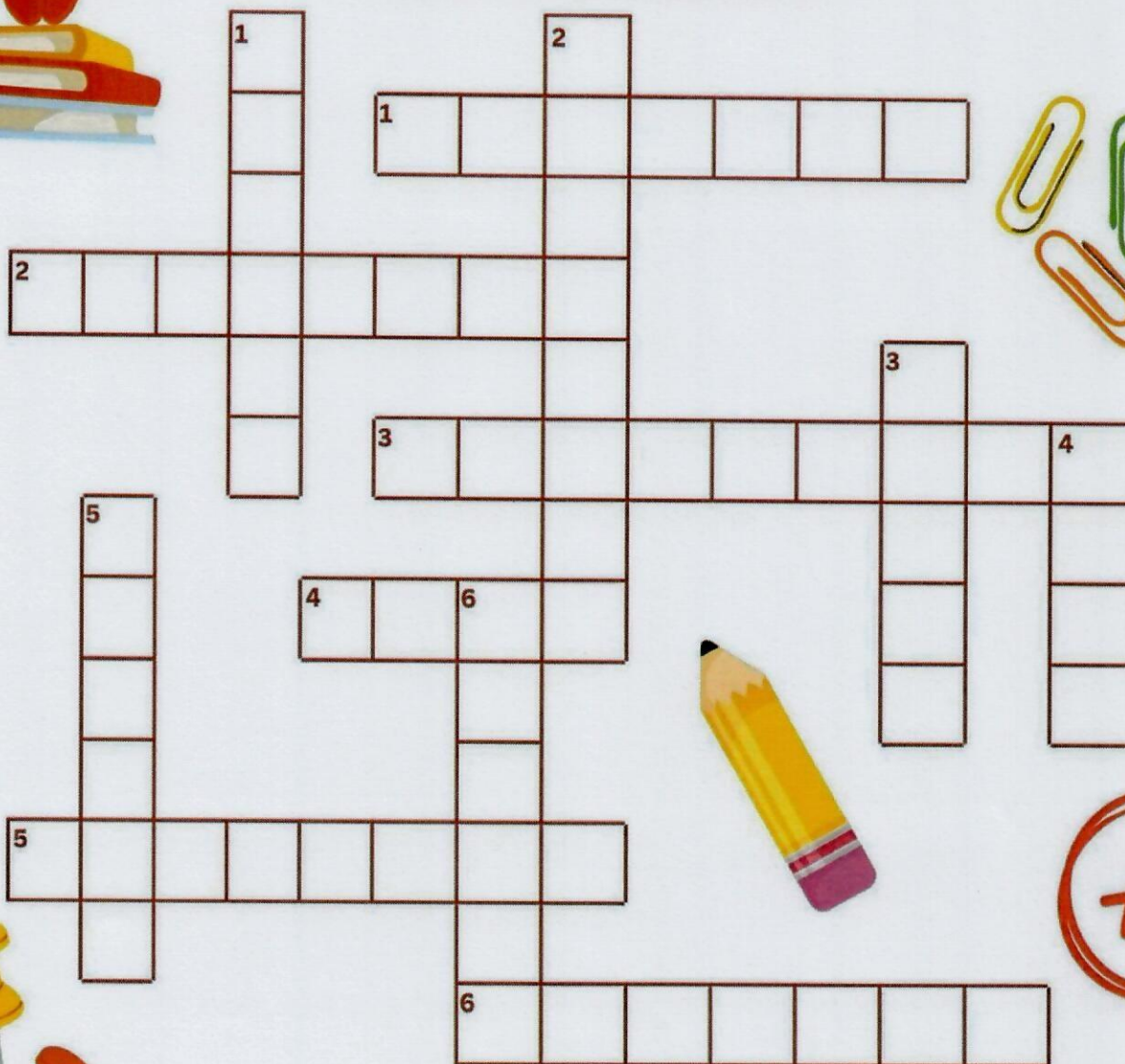
Resident Fun!

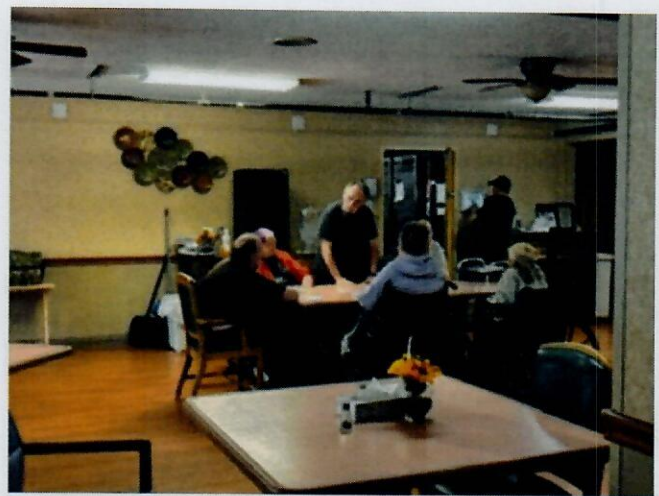
"Something wonderful is just around the corner"
