

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Instructions

- Print the puzzles and laminate them for added durability.
- There is a storage label included. I usually store the puzzles in a zip lock bag and attach the label to it with some tape.
 - Encourage the kids to say the name of each bug and the beginning sound e.g. "Apple /a/". Then find the matching puzzle piece. The letters are in different colors to help children self-correct.
 - Once the puzzles are complete, say all the names of the letters and their beginning sounds.
 - You can also talk about the upper and lower case letters in each puzzle pair, e.g. "This is the upper case B".

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
